



Based on Chazz Palminteri's own life, the story revolves around a teenage boy and his tough childhood in an Italian-American Bronx neighborhood ruled by a mob boss. Their paths meet when the boy witnesses a mob hit. While he loves his bus driver father, who has tried to instill working class family values in him, he finds himself drawn to the mystique of the crime world. He struggles with choosing between his loving father, who tries to steer him away from a corrupt life, and the organized crime father figure who captivates him.

Academy Award® nominee Palminteri (*Bullets Over Broadway*) originally wrote **A BRONX TALE** as a one-character play, in which he starred on Broadway nearly ten years ago. Earlier, he co-starred with and was directed by Robert De Niro in the movie of the same name. Now, he and De Niro join forces again as they bring a new musical adaptation to Broadway.
