Rodgers & Hammerstein's CAROUSEL premiered on Broadway in 1945, received unanimous raves and has been thrilling audiences ever since. The New York Times declared it "nothing less than a masterpiece." Its story of passion, loss and redemption introduced Broadway to a new manner of musical drama, one that "set the standard for the 20th century musical" (*Time* Magazine).

Directed by multiple Tony Award® winner Jack O'Brien (Hairspray, The Front Page, The Coast of Utopia) and choreographed by New York City Ballet's Justin Peck, it now returns to Broadway in a production starring Tony nominee Joshua Henry (Hamilton, Shuffle Along), Tony winner Jessie Mueller (Beautiful, Waitress) and celebrated opera star, Grammy Award winner Renée Fleming.

Set in a small New England town, this timeless musical tells the story of the stormy relationship between a troubled carnival barker and the young woman who gives up everything for him.
