

IF I *FORGET*

This new play centers around a gathering of a Jewish family in the months before 9/11 as three siblings celebrate their ailing father's 75th birthday. The son, a Jewish studies professor, has dedicated his provocative publication about the Holocaust, American Jews and Israel to his father. His sisters are not enthralled with his liberal ideas, and as the siblings form their individual versions of family history, they end up clashing over everything from the brother's controversial academic work to the increasing pressures of caring for their father. As secrets and long-held resentments emerge, the three negotiate—with sharp humor and cutting-edge insight—how much of the past they are willing to let go for a chance at a new start.

Written by Steven Levenson (*Dear Evan Hansen*) and directed by Tony Award® winner Daniel Sullivan (*Proof*), **IF I *FORGET*** is a powerful, humorous, poignant, extremely honest play about the stories we choose to believe, the compromises we can't avoid and the hurt only our nearest and dearest can inflict.
