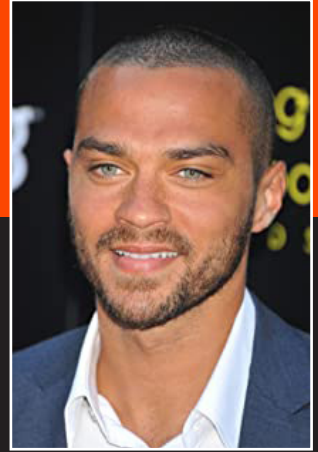


TAKE ME OUT
