But his plans to leave town with the money are thwarted when he falls for the town librarian, Marian, played by two-time Tony Award winner Sutton Foster (*Thoroughly Modern Millie*; *Anything Goes*).

Jerry Zaks directs and Warren Carlyle choreographs, reuniting after collaborating on the 2017 revival of *Hello, Dolly!*
