Following a sold-out, extended run at The Public Theater, **SUFFS** arrives on Broadway — and not a moment too soon. From the singular mind of Broadway visionary Shaina Taub, and with a producing team that includes Hillary Rodham Clinton and Malala Yousafzai, this “remarkable, epic new musical” (*Variety*) courageously delves into the victories and failures of a struggle for equality that’s far from over.

It’s 1913 and the Women’s Movement is materializing in America, anchored by a passionate group of suffragists — “Suffs,” as they call themselves — and their unrelenting pursuit of the right to vote. Taking to the streets, they risk their lives pioneering protest tactics that transformed the country.

Reaching across and against generational, racial, and class divides, these intelligent, flawed women regale and move us with the story of their hard-won victory in an ongoing fight. So much has changed since the passing of the Nineteenth Amendment over a century ago, and yet we’re reminded sometimes we need to look back, in order to march fearlessly into the future.
